



## SET "PULCINO" – Cap, Purse, Blanket yarns *NINNAO*, *AZZURRA* e *AVANTGARDE*

**YARNS**  
**ADRIAFIL YARNS**

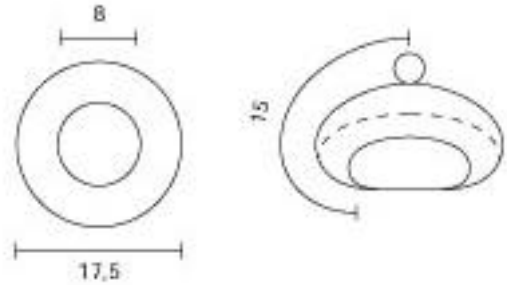
### **MATERIALS REQUIRED CAP**

50 g **Azzurra** yarn, yellow no. 05 doubled; several grams printed **Avantgarde** colour no. 62. Crochet hook no. 3.00. Two 7 cm ø cardboard rings. Tapestry needle.

**DIMENSIONS:** diameter 17.5 cm., opening 8 cm

### **PATTERN STITCHES**

Chain stitch  
Single crochet  
Double treble crochet  
Reverse stitch: work as double crochet from left to right.



### **GAUGE**

10 x 10 cm with crochet hook no. 3.50 with the Azzurra yarn doubled work a circle in half tr. = 14 half tr. and 11 rows.

### **WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Cap:** with crochet hook no. 3.50 and the Azzurra yarn doubled cast on a 5 st. chain, making a loop with 1 sc. and, in the loop obtained, work in half tr. as follows:

Row 1: 12 st.; end all the rows with 1 sc. in the initial st.  
Row 2 and 3: 2 sts. in each st. below  
Row 4: 56 sts. (from this row to row 13 space all incrs. evenly).  
Row 5: 64 sts.  
Row 6: 76 sts.  
Row 7.: 80 sts.  
Row 7: 84 sts.  
Row 9: 88 sts.  
Row 10: 82 sts.

Row 11: 72 sts.  
Row 12: 62 sts.  
Row 13: 52 sts.  
Rows 14, 15 and 16: work without variations.  
Row 17: work with the printed Avantgarde yarn doubled in reverse st.

Break off and bind the yarn. **Pompon:** make a 1.5 cm hole at the centre of the two cardboard rings. Join the two rings together and wind the yarn (printed Avantgarde) around them (thread the yarn into a tapestry needle to make this easier) filling the hole. Pass the yarn between the two rings and cut leaving a long thread. With sharp scissors, cut the wound threads fitting the tip of the scissors between the two rings (on the circumference side). Separate the rings slightly and wind the thread around the band of threads at the centre between the two rings, pulling the thread tightly; bind with a couple of stitches at the centre. Slide out the rings, and even off the threads with the scissors to make the pompon round; join the pompon at the top of the cap.

### **MATERIALS REQUIRED PURSE**

50 g **Azzurra** yarn, yellow no. 05 doubled; several threads of **Uno a Ritorto 16/3 =12** yarn in the following colours: sea green no. 08, light blue no. 09, bright yellow no. 07, pink no. 03. 10 x10 cm granny cloth or Aida canvas with 50 10 cm. squares. Crochet hook no. 3.50. Embroidery and tapestry needles.

**DIMENSIONS:** purse 11x8.5 cm.

### **PATTERN STITCHES**

Chain stitch - Single crochet - Double treble crochet  
Reverse stitch: work as double crochet from left to right - Cross stitch - Double running stitch

### **GAUGE**

10 x 10 cm with crochet hook no. 3.50 and doubling the yarn work a circle in half tr = 13 half. tr. and 14 rows.

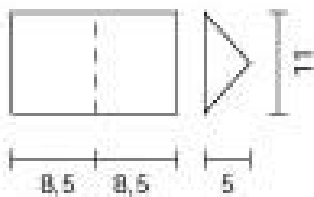
## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

With crochet hook no. 3.50 and doubling the yarn cast on a 24 st. chain and, as from the 3rd chain on the hook, work in half tr. for 11 cm.; stand off work. Pick up 16 sts. along one side edge of the section worked and, for the flap, work in half tr. decreasing on each side 1 st. every row until you have 6 sts. Stand off work.

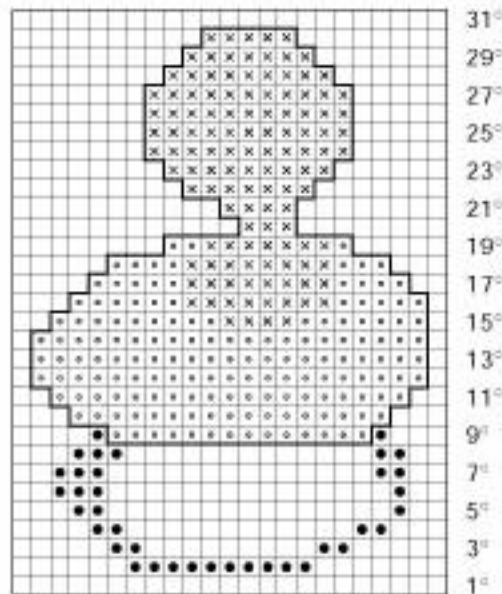
## FINISHING






Tack the granny cloth (or Aida canvas) at the centre of one half of the purse; work the embroidery pattern in cross stitch and double running stitch following the chart and the legend. When complete, slide out the granny cloth. Fold the purse in half and sew up the sides. Trim the edges in reverse stitch. For the strap, hook the yarn to one end of the opening and work a 40 cm chain; join the end of the strap to the other side of the opening.

## MATERIALS REQUIRED *BLANKET*

450 g **NinnaO'** yarn, cream no. 45; 50 g **Azzurra** yarn in the following colours: salmon no. 06, yellow no. 07, sea green no. 08, light blue no. 09. 50 g. **Avantgarde** in the following colours: pink no. 03 and lilac no. 33. Needles no. 7. Crochet hook no. 3.00. Tapestry needle.

**DIMENSIONS:** 88x76 cm.

## PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch

Garner stitch

Lily stitch: over 4 sts.

Row 1: \* p1, \* 1 yo, purl 2 tog., p2 \*, rep. from \* to \*. Row 2 and all even rows: knitted stitch.

Row 3: purl

Row 5: p1, \* 1 slot (= k1 fitting right needle into yo of row below and, at the same time, drop the 1st stitch of the left needle), p1, 1 yo, purl 2 tog. \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Row 7 f.: purl

Row 9: p1, \* 1 yo, purl 2 tog., 1 slot, p1 \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Row 11: repeat from row 3

Single crochet

Double crochet

Double treble crochet

## GAUGE

10 x 10 cm with needles no. 7 in stockinette stitch = 11 sts. and 15 rows

## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

The blanket consists of 3 bands (two of which are the same) worked separated and trimmed with 6 groups of 3 flowers. **Band one:** with needles no. 7 and the Ninnaò yarn cast on 31 sts. and work \* 2 rows in garter st.; cont. establishing the stitches as follows: 3 sts in garter st., 24 sts. in lily stitch, 1 st. in purled stitch, 3 sts. in garter st. When work measures 17 cm., work 2 rows in garter st.; cont. in stockinette stitch working the first and last 3 sts. in garter st. \*. When work measures 17 cm., rep. from \* to \* 1 more time; work 2 rows in garter st., then bind off all the stitches. **Band two:** with needles no. 7 and the Ninnaò yarn cast on 31 sts. and work \*2 rows in garter st.; cont. in stockinette stitch working the first and last 3 sts. in garter st. When work measures 17 cm., work 2 rows in garter st. Cont. establishing the stitches as follows: 3 sts. in garter st., 24 sts. in lily stitch, 1 st. in purled stitch, 3 sts. in garter st. \*. When work measures 17 cm., rep. from \* to \* 1 more time; work 2 rows in garter st., then bind off all the stitches. **Band three:** work in same way as band one. **Flowers:** With crochet hook no. 3.00 and the Azzurra or Avantgarde yarn cast on a 5 st. chain, closing with a loop made by working 1 sc in the 1st chain; in the loop obtained, work: row 1 \* 1 dc, 5 chs. \*, rep. from \* to \*; ending with 1 sc. in the beg. stitch. Row 2: in each loop below work 1 dc, 1 half tr. 5 trs., 1 half tr. 1 dc; ending with 1 sc. in the beg. stitch. Without breaking off the yarn, work a 25 st. chain. (stalk). Break off and bind the yarn. Work another 17 flowers in the same way using the yarns and colours you prefer, or keep to the colours shown by the picture.

## FINISHING

Join the bands so as to alternate the different motifs. Trim the edge of the blanket with Azzurra yarn as follows: Row 1 (yellow) \* in the same cable st. work 5 trs., skip 2 sts., 1 dc, skip 1 st. \*, rep. from \* to \*; end this row and the next rows with 1 sc. in the initial st.

Row 2: (salmon) \* 1 dc of the centre tr. of the next group, 5 trs. in the next dc. \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Row 3: (yellow) work in same way as row 2

Break off and bind the yarn.

Sew on the flowers in the squares in stockinette stitch; arrange the motifs in groups of 3 alternating the colours as you prefer or use the colours shown by the picture.
